CCPPD Crews Assisting with Fair Foundation Barn Move

Short power interruptions expected

Cuming County Public Power District customers that reside on lines along the route of a large barn move can expect periodical outages beginning on Tuesday, January 14 at 8:00 AM. The District will be assisting the Fair Board Foundation as they move a barn from the Norbert Ruskamp farm located in Lincoln Township in southwest Cuming County to the fairgrounds in West Point. The dates and times can change dependent on weather and other unforeseen events.

CCPPD crews are completing preliminary work on our lines to minimize both the number and duration of outages to our customers. Due to the anticipated structure height of 50 feet, district customers will still be out of power periodically during the move.

The District advises customers to take appropriate measures to insure that they will not be adversely affected by any interruption in electrical service. The district will try to keep the public informed by providing periodical updates to KTIC/KWPN radio stations, Face book page and CCPPD.com website.

The route chosen by the movers will begin at the intersection of 5th and B roads traveling north to D before turning east to 12th road. The route turns north on 12th to highway 32. From there the barn follows highway 32 to West Point. Tentative plans call for the barn to reach the city of West Point by 4:00 PM. CCPPD will pass on more information once the plans are finalized and communicated from the movers.
