NPPD - doing a decarbonization survey. The question was posed to our directors about how we want to inform our customers to go out and voice their opinion. The direction from the board was to be very direct about the consequences could be if coal is totally removed from the equation.

NPPD - the R line is currently dead in the water, but will be addressed again probably in 2025. There is no back up plan.
